



Am I Eligible?

If you find you are not eligible, please ask your YMCA about other membership options. We are here to offer our help and support!

The Department of Defense has contracted with the Armed Services YMCA to fund memberships at participating YMCAs throughout the United States and Puerto Rico for the following **Title 10 DoD Military Groups:**

Families of Deployed National Guard and Reserve

Eligibility: Active Duty Title 10 Only (Title 32 personnel not authorized due to funding restrictions)

- Families of Guard/Reserve personnel who are deployed for a minimum of 6 months.
- Deploying Service member eligible for YMCA membership with family for three months pre and post deployment.
- Families are eligible for the duration of the deployment, not to exceed 18 months (which includes Service member 3 months pre and post deployment).
- Membership is renewable in six month increments contingent upon use (8 individual days per month).
- Minimum length of membership is six months.
- Single Service Members Do Not Qualify for this Membership- Families or Spouse Only.

What do I need for registration?

- A copy of deployment orders and a military ID card must be presented when applying for YMCA membership

Relocated Spouse/Dependent Children of Deployed Active Duty Personnel

Eligibility: Title 10 Only (Title 32 personnel not authorized due to funding restrictions)

The Relocated Spouse category was included in the YMCA contract to support families/spouse who relocate away from an installation/duty station while the active duty service member is deployed. All of the following criteria must be met:

- The Service member is on active duty.
- The Service member is DEPLOYED for a minimum of six months (on deployment orders—NOT unaccompanied orders, NOT geographic bachelors).
- The spouse has relocated away from the military installation where the Service member is assigned (most often, back home near family).
- The YMCA membership is authorized in six months increments for a total of 12 months contingent upon use (8 individual days per month)

What do I need for registration?

- A copy of deployment orders and active military dependent (spouse or child) ID card must be presented when applying for YMCA membership

Active Duty Assigned to Independent Duty Locations

Eligibility: Active Duty Title 10 Only. (Title 32 personnel not authorized due to funding restrictions)

- Authorized only for those commands who have no access to free fitness equipment and are not receiving funding for fitness memberships at any location. Must Contact Military One Source for the Proper Military Approver – All done through e-mail .

What do I need for registration?

Each Service has a point of contact who will approve requests (contact Military One Source for your military approver's e-mail address and contact Information). Company commanders must authorize the request but they do not approve the request. See the process as follows:

- Independent Duty commands must fill out one Unit request for all interested command personnel
- Request must be signed by Commanding Officer and sent to Service POC for approval prior to going to the YMCA
- Family members are included in YMCA membership for Independent Duty personnel
- Membership will be authorized in six-month increments contingent upon use (8 individual days per month)
- Approved Approval Request Letter and military ID card required to be presented for YMCA membership

Single Service members at approved IDP locations: (See note)

- May opt to join private fitness facility or the YMCA /Unit Must come to a consensus on private fitness provider
- Limited to a maximum of \$50 per month ****Any fee over \$50 will be the responsibility of the Service member***
- Registration fees are the responsibility of Service member
- ASYMCA will negotiate membership fees for a 6 month pre paid contract
- Membership will be authorized in six month increments contingent upon use (8 individual days per month)
- Approval letter and military ID card required for private fitness facility membership

Community Based Warrior Transition Unit (CBWTU)

Eligibility: Title 10 Only (Title 32 personnel not authorized due to funding restrictions)

- Those eligible have military orders to a Community Based Warrior Transition Unit. The Service member is based at their home location on 6 months orders to complete rehabilitation. An IDP is Not Required. This may be a family or single membership which will be renewable in six month increments. Note: Service members assigned to a CBWTU receive orders for six months at a time, renewed based on their rehabilitative progress. Any Service member with a current set of orders to a CBWTU is eligible regardless of the remaining time on their orders. Renewals will also be allowed as long as the Service member has a current set of orders, regardless of the duration.

What do I need for registration?

- A copy of military orders to a CBWTU and military ID card must be presented when applying for YMCA membership.
