Child Care First Aid Permission

The only First Aid measures taken at the Child Care Site are as follows: Burn or bruise: Apply ice, if needed. Cut or Scratch: Clean with soap and water. Apply bandage if needed. Nose Bleed: Apply pressure. Splinter: First Aid by a qualified person. (Invasive measures like needles or tweezing into the skin will not be used.) If further care is needed, a parent/guardian will be notified.

Child Care Photo Authorization

I give my consent to let my child be photographed for use by the YMCA in newspapers, newsletters, program guides etc., for the purpose of advertisement or promotion or by media outlets approved by the YMCA.

Child Care Proper Conduct Agreement

This Code of Conduct is put in place to guarantee a supportive space for all to enjoy, feel safe and reach their highest potential. The following list of unacceptable behavior is subject to unilateral change by the YMCA management at any time and is by no means exhaustive in nature. Nor does this mean that any behavior that is not included on this list, but which is clearly detrimental to the YMCA, our participants or other staff will be considered acceptable. 1. Mistreatment of other participants, staff or volunteers. This includes staff that does not work with the school age program. 2. Racial, ethnic, bias or any other form or harassment in any form towards the public, participants or staff. 3. The damage, loss or destruction of YMCA or school property or the possessions of staff, volunteers or participants due to a willful or careless act, including graffiti. 4. Theft or dishonesty. 5. Fighting, swearing or abusive language. 6. Breaking the law or committing an unlawful act in association with the YMCA. 7. Violation of any commonly acceptable or reasonable rules of responsible conduct. 8. All other rules developed by the YMCA or Program Sites. 9. Leaving the program premises without permission or going into areas where a staff member is not present to monitor the participant's behavior. 10. Refusing to follow check in and check out procedures. I also understand the following: I acknowledge and agree to the policies laid out in this agreement and will follow and obey them. I have discussed these items with my child and he or she knows and agrees to follow all of these rules.

Child Care Registration Agreement

I, the undersigned parent/guardian agree: 1. To pay non-refundable registration fee for each child participating. 2. To pay for the marked months/days/weeks according to the outlined fee schedule. 3. Monthly fees must be paid prior to attendance or automatically on the due dates. 4. For YEAR-ROUND option participants: registration into this option is

available until October 31st of the current school year. 5. A two-week written notice must be given by parent/guardian to cancel or change the contract for services or I will be liable for payments until written notice is given. 6. A two-week written notice must be given by parent/guardian to use "payment vacation" week(s) available with registration into the Option 1 and Option 2 programs. "Payment vacation" must occur in five consecutive days-Monday through Friday. 6. Termination of the services agreement at any time no longer holds a place for my child in the YMCA Child Care Program and requires me to pay another registration fee for my child to return to care. Switching to a different option may result in additional fees assessed.

Child Care Statement of Understanding

I have read the Parent/Guardian Handbook and understand the policies/procedures of the YMCA of the Cedar Rapids Metropolitan Area's School Age Child Care Program. **(A copy of the parent handbook can be accessed through the YMCA website.)**

Child Care Transportation Authorization

I give permission for my child to participate in the following: Trips, tours, walks and special events under the supervision of YMCA staff. Notifications of any off-site activity will be given in advance. Movies or videos may be shown. If the rating is anything other than "G", notice will be given and you can request that your child not view it and have alternate activities such as reading, or arts and crafts instead. Speakers from the community may be invited during specific theme programming.

Child Care Waiver

I give my permission for my child to participate in the YMCA School Age Child Care Program. In doing so, I agree to release the YMCA, its staff and its volunteers from any responsibility in case of injury.

Exculpatory Agreement

YMCA In consideration of membership current or new, or participating in YMCA activities, and for other good and valuable consideration, I hereby agree to release and discharge from liability arising from negligence the YMCA of the Cedar Rapids Metropolitan Area and its owners, directors, officers, employees, agents, volunteers, participants, and all other persons or entities acting for them (hereinafter collectively referred to as Releases, on behalf of myself and my children, parents, heirs, assigns, personal representative and estate, and also agree as follows:

1. I acknowledge that participating in YMCA activities involves known and unanticipated risks which could result in physical or emotional injury, paralysis or permanent disability, death, and property damage. Risks include, but are not limited to, broken bones, torn ligaments or other injuries as a result of falls or contact with other participants; death as a result of drowning or brain damage caused by near drowning in pools or other bodies of

water; medical conditions resulting from physical activity; and damaged clothing or other property. I understand such risks simply cannot be eliminated, despite the use of safety equipment, without jeopardizing the essential qualities of the activity.

2. I expressly accept and assume all of the risks inherent in this activity or that might have been caused by the negligence of the Releases. My participation in this activity is purely voluntary and I elect to participate despite the risks. In addition, if at any time I believe that event conditions are unsafe or that I am unable to participate due to physical or medical conditions, then I will immediately discontinue participation.

3. I hereby voluntarily release, forever discharge, and agree to indemnify and hold harmless Releases from any and all claims, demands, or causes of action which are in any way connected with my participation in this activity, or my use of their equipment or facilities, arising from negligence. This release does not apply to claims arising from intentional conduct. Should Releases or anyone acting on their behalf be required to incur attorney's fees and costs to enforce this agreement, I agree to indemnify and hold them harmless for all such fees and costs.

4. I represent that I have adequate insurance to cover any injury or damage I may suffer or cause while participating in this activity, or else I agree to bear the costs of such injury or damage myself. I further represent that I have no medical or physical condition which could interfere with my safety in this activity, or else I am willing to assume and bear the costs of all risks that may be created, directly or indirectly, by any such condition.

5. In the event that I file a lawsuit, I agree to do so in the state where Releases facility is located, and I further agree that the substantive law of that state shall apply.

6. I agree that if any portion of this agreement is found to be void or unenforceable, the remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

7. By participating in the YMCA Nationwide Membership Program, I agree to release the National Council of Young Men's Christian Associations of the United States of America, and its independent and autonomous member associations in the United States and Puerto Rico, from claims of negligence for bodily injury or death in connection with the use of YMCA facilities, and from any liability for other claims, including loss of property, to the fullest extent of the law.

Youth, Tae Kwon Do, Tee Pee Village Programs, Treadmill Trekkers, Visitor Day Passes, Volleyball Programs, Wapsie Camp Retreats, Wapsie Campouts, Wapsie Team Building Programs, Water Movement, Water Stamina Programs, Water Acclimation Programs, White Water Rafting, Wilderness First Aid, Wilderness, Education, Winter Camp, shooting sports, riflery, Archery

The above list is not intended to be and is not exhaustive. There may be YMCA activities the undersigned participates in which are not listed above; but said activities are intended to be and are included in the terms and conditions of this release. By signing this document, I agree that if I am hurt or my property is damaged during my participation in this activity,

then I may be found by a court of law to have waived my right to maintain a lawsuit against the parties being released on the basis of any claim for negligence. Further, I grant the YMCA of the Cedar Rapids Metropolitan Area permission to use photos and/or videos of myself and/or my family taken during YMCA programs, classes and activities to be used in its promotional materials, locally and nationally and grant the YMCA of the Cedar Rapids Metropolitan Area permission to send SMS text notifications to my mobile phone and/or devices. Lastly, the YMCA conducts regular sex offender screenings on all members, participants, and guests. If a sex offender match occurs, the YMCA reserves the right to cancel membership, end program participation, and remove visitation access. I have had sufficient time to read this entire document and, should I choose to do so, consult with legal counsel prior to signing. Also, I understand that this activity might not be made available to me or that the cost to engage in this activity would be significantly greater if I were to choose not to sign this release, and agree that the opportunity to participate at the stated cost in return for the execution of this release is a reasonable bargain. I have read and understood this document and I agree to be bound by its terms.
